## $S_{2}$-Small Groups: Organize to Maximize Exodus 18:13-23

## I. The Problem: very little was getting done.

A. The people were worn out. Morale was low, disputes were breaking out and people's needs went $\qquad$ .
B. The leader was worn out. He could only see what was
$\qquad$ of him.

## II. The Solution.

A. Understand this principle: You are gifted to do works of ministry that others in the church are $\qquad$ gifted to do.
B. Organize to maximize: start out $\qquad$ and distribute the load according to giftedness.

1. Assign ministries within your $\qquad$ (teacher, assistant teacher, prayer leader, ministry leaders, fellowship leader, welcome/hospitality leader, outreach leader, follow-up leader).
2. Ask yourself: can anyone else do what you are doing, if you $\qquad$ them (Eph. 4:12)?

## III. The Results.

A. People will be at peace and $\qquad$ how they fit in with the mission/strategy of the church.
B. The distributed load will help everyone $\qquad$ and not burn-out.
C. Disciples will be made, new small groups $\qquad$ and the church will grow.
