***John 10:1-21***

***I. The Sheepfold***

- A. It was a place where sheep were \_\_\_\_\_ at night. It was not, however, impenetrable.
- B. The sheepfold held many flocks. The shepherds would come and call their sheep \_\_\_\_\_ to lead them out.
- C. The sheep will \_\_\_\_\_ the shepherd's voice when they are called.
1. The external call of the gospel – \_\_\_\_\_ people are called to repent and believe.
  2. The internal (\_\_\_\_\_) call of the gospel – God draws a sinner unto salvation through the work of the Holy Spirit (John 6:44).
- D. Jesus said, I AM the Door unto \_\_\_\_\_. I will lead you out of this enclosure that doesn't really protect, this captivity that appears safer, but will not save (Is. 61:1).

***II. I AM the Good Shepherd.***

- A. The Good Shepherd \_\_\_\_\_ from the flock in times of trouble; He protects it.
- B. The Good Shepherd \_\_\_\_\_ the flock to find food and be nourished (Jer. 15:16).
