

***Ruth: Experiencing the Attributes of God.***  
*Ruth Chapter 2*

- I. *Providence*** - God's divine governance for his people as he guides them in their journey of faith through life, accomplishing His purposes in them. This is the opposite of chance or fate.
- A. God directed Ruth to an \_\_\_\_\_ family member of Naomi.
- B. God's purpose for Ruth was to not only take care of her mother-in-law, but to be part of the \_\_\_\_\_ family line.
- II. *Protection*** – God shields you from the accessibility of the enemy, no matter what the \_\_\_\_\_.
- A. Ruth sought the God of Israel, “under whose wings she had come to take \_\_\_\_\_ (Psalm 46:1-2a; Psalm 91:1-4).”
- B. \_\_\_\_\_ believers are protected eternally. There are those here on earth who are supernaturally protected temporally. God used Boaz to protect Ruth from being assaulted.
- III. *Provision*** – God provides everything for us. He provides supernaturally when our own means are inadequate.
- A. Ruth left her homeland to go to a \_\_\_\_\_ without a husband or a job. Her means were inadequate.
- B. God used Boaz to provide more than a daily portion of food and He used Him to provide food \_\_\_\_\_.
