I.	Spending wisely begins with knowing how to work
A.	Teach yourself and your children that there is no such thing as "" that will not have
	consequences down the road (Prov. 10:4; 13:4; 14:23).
В.	Understand that "get rich quick" schemes are wasters (Prov. 20:21, 21:5-6).
II.	Spending wisely keeps track of how the money is spent by using a budget.
A.	fixed, variable and miscellaneous expenses.
В.	Learn to spend percent of your take home pay after taxes (Prov. 15:16; 16:8; 17:1).
C.	Keep yourself from incurring further debt by developing a to pay off the ones you have currently (Prov. 22:7).
III.	Spending wisely recognizes its limits.
A.	Develop a "" that works for you (envelope method, recording sheet, etc.). Limits teach us patience and what is important (Prov. 27:23-24).
В.	Be creative in costs (barter services deal/negotiate, Look for discounts, second hand stores/consignment shops, yard sales, generic brands, coupon codes, etc.).
